THE OPENING FACEOFF... NEW ARRIVALS

With the Florida Panthers winning their first Stanley Cup after 30 seasons and the Denver (TENver?) Pioneers adding a 10th National Championship to their collection of banners, we enter the silly season. That means free agency in professional hockey and the transfer portal for NCAA hockey. Coaching changes abound as well highlighted by the entire coaching staff walking out the door at Northern Michigan University "for other opportunities." As we have seen the past few off-seasons, the fifth "Covid season" for many players has put an above average number of players in the portal as graduate students take advantage of an additional year of NCAA eligibility.

We've had a busy few months since the last newsletter with another nice group of new jerseys arriving, highlighted by our acquisition of a collection which focused on vintage Dartmouth going back to the 1990s and a few Univ of New Hampshire jersey as well. Other notable arrivals include a couple dozen BU gamers and practice jerseys - complete with names, numbers and Hockey East conference patches, (yes, all that on practice jerseys) along with many more from Brown, Denver, Miami, Ferris State, Bemidji State, Vermont and Michigan Tech. The Vermont is notable as this is the first set I have seen produced by Smarthockey. Another new manufacturer now added to men's D-I hockey. TIMEOUT FOR COACHING... WHY IS THAT LOGO OBSCURED?

If you've seen a few 1990s era jerseys, you have almost certainly come across one or more that have the manufacturer's logo covered and you may have wondered why. Back then, the NCAA decided to crack down on what they perceived to be overt advertising on college jerseys and in short decided that a manufacturer's or supplier's logo could be no larger than one square inch. That's not very large, and it left many teams scrambling to bring their jerseys into compliance without having to replace all of them. Patching over the offending logos became the most common fix. In the coming years, suppliers either greatly reduced the size of their logo (CCM for example) or they came up with creative ways around the rule like printing matched to the jersey color so the logo could only be seen up close.

AT THE END OF REGULATION... MORE CONFERENCE SHUFFLING

The past year has provided notice that at least two Men's D-I teams are on the move and getting new conference homes. Exactly one year ago today, the NCHC announced that they would be undertaking their



first expansion since the conference formed in 2013 by adding the Arizona State Sun Devils as their 9th member for the 2024-25 season. After almost a decade as a D-I independent, ASU got their new rink Mullet Arena completed and their rink roommate, the NHL's Arizona Coyotes' assets (but not officially the franchise), left town to become the Utah Hockey Club. With ASU being an oddball 9th team in the conference, most speculated it wouldn't be long before the NCHC would want a 10th team. They were correct.

However, almost everyone incorrectly assumed it would be WCHA/CCHA powerhouse Minnesota State who got the invite. The college hockey world was a bit shocked when the upstart Univ of St Thomas Tommies, led by former Miami head coach Rico Blasi, announced that they would be leaving the CCHA to join the NCHC starting with the 2006-27 season, leaving them to play two lame duck seasons in the CCHA before departing. One can't help but wonder if the NCHC changed course after seeing the Wisconsin



Badgers gut Mankato's hockey program when they hired away not just head coach Mike Hastings, but also their assistant coach Todd Knott, director of sports performance Tom Inkrott, and director of hockey operations Luke Regner.

Lastly, two conferences announced their merger this past April when College Hockey America (women's) and Atlantic Hockey (men's) came together under the new name Atlantic Hockey America. Previously the two conferences had shared administrative operations since 2010. Will this lead to more conference shuffling out
